

Sixth Form 2021 Entrance Process Update (29th September 2020)

Assessment

The assessment date will remain as Saturday 7th November.

The number of papers will be reduced (there will not be a general paper), allowing us to sequence small groups on the day. The outcome of both papers will be taken into consideration.

45-minute English paper: this test comprises a number of questions in response to a literary passage.

45-minute Maths paper: a non-calculator paper. Problem-solving skills and basic skills, including algebra, will be assessed.

On Saturday 7th November candidates will have a tour of the school and meet members of the sixth form team.

All candidates will be interviewed over Zoom during the period of Monday 9th November to Friday 20th November.

The interview will involve a conversation about their A level options and co-curricular activities as well as a discussion about a topical article they will be shown during the interview. This is also a great opportunity for the candidates to ask any questions they have about life in the Emanuel Sixth Form.

The offers made will be unconditional; however, pupils must achieve a grade of 7 or above for the subjects they wish to study at A level (or subjects studied at GCSE which have similar skills sets to new subjects offered at A level) as detailed in the A level options booklet: <u>https://www.emanuel.org.uk/academic/emanuel-curriculum/</u>. Additionally, if an applicant wishes to study Maths at A level, they will need at least an 8 at GCSE, and those studying Physics at A level must also be studying A level Maths.

If the required GCSE grades are not achieved for the pupil's preferred A level courses a discussion with the school to determine the best A level options for the pupil will be required.

The minimum requirements set for A level courses ensures that new joiners to the Emanuel Sixth Form will be able to maintain the academic pace needed to engage with their chosen subjects confidently and successfully.

Offers will be sent on Thursday 26th November. The acceptance deadline is Tuesday 8th December. These dates have not changed.

Exam Concessions

It is vital that applications for exam concessions are sent to the admissions office by the deadline of Friday 16th October (this date has not changed). Unfortunately, late applications cannot be considered.

School report

It is very important that we receive a copy of the candidate's latest school report. We are aware that many schools will have written shorter reports for the summer term, and that these reports reflect an extremely unusual time. Please do not be concerned as we will read these reports mindful of the context in which they were written. The deadline for submission of school reports is Friday 16th October (this date has not changed).

Headteacher's reference

As usual, we will be requesting a headteacher's reference for each candidate. This reference is an important aspect of the application.
