By all accounts, Emanuel is going from strength to strength. Under the watchful eye of Head Robert Milne, 2019 saw the highest number of applicants at every entry point, 48.5 per cent of A-levels were A\* or A grades (up 15 per cent from 2018) and 82 per cent of pupils received offers from their first-choice university. But this is no hothouse. Children are notably happy and relaxed, and, according to one parent, the pastoral care is 'fantastic'. Its situation, just a short walk from bustling Clapham Junction, means it attracts pupils from far and wide (though 60 per cent walk, cycle or scooter to school) and 21 per cent of children are on some form of financial assistance. The food boasts its own Instagram account (think Thai beef salad, Moroccan root vegetable tagine and banana and chocolate chip cake) and sport is extremely strong with one student bringing home two rowing gold medals for Great Britain in 2019. Both the co-founder of Wikipedia and the CMO of Google gave inspiring talks at the school last year, and two popular new subjects have been introduced to Years 6 and 7 – Computing and Design & Robotics – alongside 'Ethos', an ethics and debating course. Pupils are delighted with their smart new uniforms, and a new science building and refectory are on the horizon. It's no wonder parents are 'very excited to see what Emanuel will achieve for its students and staff in the coming years'. Watch this space.
