- A statement written by the candidate about why they would like to be a drama scholar at Emanuel School (maximum length 500 words). Candidates are likely to be questioned about this if called to audition. This statement should include a summary of what the candidate can offer the school in terms of drama and what they would hope to gain by being part of the drama scholarship programme. Pupils may wish to explain any previous drama experience, both in and out of school.
- A theatre review written by the candidate about a play or performance they have seen in the last year (maximum length 500 words). It is intended that this will show the candidate's understanding of how drama is created as well as reflecting their appreciation that drama is not solely about being a performer.

A panel will review the supporting evidence and will be looking for examples which clearly show that the candidate has a genuine passion for, knowledge of and dedication to drama and the potential to benefit from the scholarship programme at Emanuel. Statements and reviews will be assessed on content, not style. Please note that supporting evidence will be retained by the school.
