

Examination results in 2020 and 2021

Emanuel pupils obtained excellent results in 2020 and 2021. As formal public examinations could not take place, these were achieved by following the protocols required by the Government and Ofqual for the specific year.

Grades for A levels and (I)GCSEs in 2020 were awarded by way of centre assessed/predicted grades and in 2021 by teacher/school assessed grades.

In 2020, teachers were asked to predict the grades in each subject that a pupil would have achieved had exams been able to take place.

In 2021, teachers were asked to provide an evidence-based judgment of the performance standard of a pupil in each subject. At Emanuel, pupils sat assessments in school in the summer term, which were run by our exams team like public examinations and used GCSE and A Level papers from previous years. Pupils revised for these papers as they would have done in any 'normal' year, and their teachers marked them by applying examination mark schemes. These assessment results were used as the basis for evidence-based grades in almost all cases, together with coursework in some subjects.

Emanuel U6 pupils performed extremely well in both years. For their A levels in 2021, 76% of all grades awarded were A and A*. In 2020, over 50% were A and A*.

At (I)GCSE in 2021, just under 90% of all grades awarded were 9/8/7. In 2020, over 75% were 9/8/7.
