The new personal statement for 2026 entry

For students applying to university for 2026 entry, the personal statement format will be changing from one longer piece of text to three separate sections. UCAS have said that: "In our commitment to equity and inclusion, we believe that every student deserves a fair chance to articulate their unique journey, aspirations, and potential. The new scaffolding questions level the playing field, providing clear guidance and structure for all applicants, regardless of their background or prior experience with essay writing. Scaffolding questions offer students a roadmap, breaking them down into manageable parts.

By providing specific prompts, students gain clarity on what to address, fostering focus and coherence in their writing.


US Summer Programmes
